

THE COMMUNITY PROBLEM

WHAT THE EDUCATION SYSTEM IS DOING TO CHILDREN AND THEIR PARENTS JUST ISN'T RIGHT!

- Only 18.7% of persons with disabilities are employed in contrast to 65.7 percent of persons without disabilities.
- 32% of workers with disabilities are employed part-time. In comparison to 17% of workers without disabilities having part-time jobs.
- The Florida Chamber Foundation shows that 62.9% of persons with disabilities are not in the labor force.
- Florida's students with disabilities are 2.7 times as likely to be suspended and 17.4 times as likely to be expelled.
- Law enforcement is 7.8 times as likely to arrest students with learning disabilities at school.
- Nearly 345,000 suspensions each year in Florida.





17% of all students enrolled in school have some type of learning disability. There are over enrolled 217,000 students in the NE Florida public schools.

1 in 8 youth have a disability that is either *hidden or not* diagnosed and therefore not accommodated properly in school. This is why most behavior issues occur.

Over 53% of our cases are students age 5-11 years old in grades K-5 with the *majority* of those being in 2nd grade and 8 years old

These children are not getting an equal opportunity in school and are struggling just to keep up in their classes.

Children with disabilities grow up to become adults with disabilities. The disability never goes away.

While students are still in school, an Individual Education Plan will ensure they are getting an education and make a *dramatic* change in the end results for these kids



MEET JUST TWO OF THE KIDS WE'VE MADE A DIFFERENCE FOR



This is Joseph. He's a cute kid isn't he? You would never know just by his picture that he has learning disabilities. Joseph has a speech impairment, a deficit in executive functioning, social anxiety, and sensory issues. But with the help of his **Individual Education Plan** (IEP) the school has been able to help him manage his deficits and improve his learning according to his abilities. **He finally enjoys school!**

Michael was a sophomore in high school and not going to graduate on time. His whole life, he didn't have the right things in place to help him in school. The school didn't take his parents or his diagnosis seriously. They weren't really giving him an education. Michael was stuck and gave up hope for graduating or going to college. When we got his **Individual Education Plan** right, Michael prevailed in his classes and graduated on time! Today he is gainfully employed and saving his money for community college to achieve his dream in animation.
